Patricia Miranda



This year the juror for our annual show will be Patricia Miranda—artist, curator and educator using interdisciplinary projects to make connections between art, science, history and culture. Patricia is founder of The Crit Lab, a graduate-level critique seminar for professional artists, and MAPSpace, a gallery project space in Port Chester NY where she developed a Collaborative Workspace Residency. She received an artist grant from Arts Westchester and was part of an NEA grant working with homeless youth. She has been awarded numerous residencies at I-Park, Weir Farm, Vermont Studio Center, Truro Center for the Arts, Spring Island Trust and Julio Valdez Printmaking Residency. Her teaching experience includes Lyme Academy, core faculty member of MFA program art New Hampshire Institute of Art, and on the faculty at Western Colorado State University and Concordia College NY. She was gallery director at Concordia College from 2008-12. She received her BFA from Purchase College, SUNY, and her MFA from Vermont College of Fine Arts. Her work has been exhibited all over the States as well.

The Guilford Art League was founded in 1947 by a small group of local artists. The objective of the art league is to promote and stimulate interest in the visual arts. Members and associates of the Guilford Art League are a participating and interactive group of artists who learn and benefit from their association with one another.

Open to all Connecticut artists, 18 years or older. Works deemed inappropriate for any reason by GAL will not be accepted. The juror’s decisions are final. Work must be ORIGINAL, not created under tutelage and not previously shown at the Art Center.

ART MEDIA

All media are eligible, including oils, watercolor, pastels, acrylics, sculpture, collage, mixed media and printmaking. If you use photos for reference, they must be your own photos. Reproductions (giclee prints), crafts, photography, or computer art will not be accepted. No size limit. All work must be for sale. All work must be suitably wired and ready for hanging. No sawtooth hangers or clips. Pedestals can be supplied if needed.

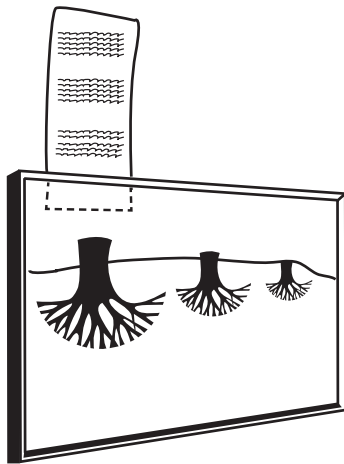

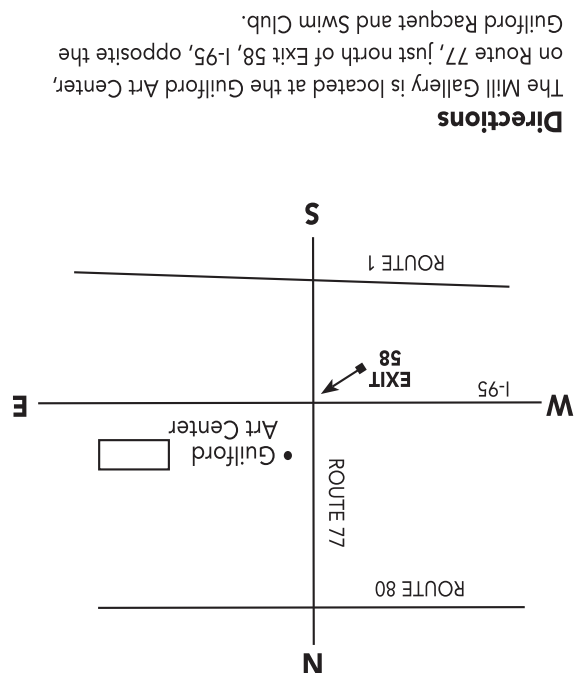
